In the mid 1950's, Archbishop Connolly had a dream of expanding Catholic secondary education to provide quality Catholic education for all students. In 1963, following the assassination of US President John F. Kennedy, the decision was made to build and name a new school in the south end, to honor the late president. In 1966, Kennedy Catholic High School opened its doors to 250 students.
