DETAILS: The St. Martin de Porres Shelter provides safe and dignified shelter for homeless men aged 50+. The shelter opened in 1984 in response to the growing need for an emergency shelter for elderly men who are vulnerable to the weather, street predators, and illness. This is to be done in the spirit of ministry of presence, which fosters attention to the individual and respect for each person's unique situation. We will be preparing, cooking, and serving lunch as well as cleaning up afterwards. *Photo consent form is required.*
